MPN continued to make new connections throughout Montana in 2019, and is looking forward to joining with yet more individuals and organizations in launching new partnerships and exploring our state's diverse communities through get-togethers, workshops and other special events in 2020. We're excited to share a progress report of the Helena Avenue Theatre in pictures. We'll soon have a fully equipped 73 seat theatre; two spacious dressing rooms; green room; costume and properties studios; equipment storage; control booth; and a fundraising space called the *Hat Box* that will be open before and during intermissions at performances. Anticipated opening is slated for early April, 2020!









### **MPN 2019 Montana Premiere Project**

This exciting project began in 2018 with three Montana performing arts companies screen-

ing script submissions by MPN members. These companies then chose scripts to produce as part of their 2019 seasons in partnership with MPN.

The first appeared in October, 2019, and was produced in **Havre** by the **Montana Actors' Theatre**. Directed by Andi Daniel, the *Vorbit Incident*, a comedy

written by Missoula playwright, Jay Kettering was very well received by the sold-out crowds in attendance.



The **Missoula** production appeared in November, 2019, at **the Downtown Dance Collective.** It featured **The Poppovichs by** playwright, Leah Joki, and was produced by Heather Adams. This bittersweet comedy featured compelling actors from out side Missoula as well as local talent and was well attended by rapt audiences.
